

## STEWARDSHIP ENCOURAGES TRUST IN GOD

When Jesus spent time with people, He spoke about many topics, but by far He spent the most time talking about the Kingdom of God and about money. Regarding money, 16 of Jesus' 38 parables dealt with finances and possessions. In the Gospels, an amazing one out of 10 verses (288 in total) deal directly with the subject of finances.

Why so much talk from Jesus about money?

Because how you think about and manage money reveals a lot about who you are. Jesus said it this way, "Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be." (Matthew 6:21)

In the Bible we learn that winning with money is not measured by who has the most, but who is the most faithful with what (s)he has. Specifically, we are called to be a manager of what we have. It is the job of a manager to take care of what does not belong to him. The manager is not the owner. Similarly, when it comes to what we possess it all belongs to the Lord (Psalm 24:1-The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it). Therefore, the money in your bank account is His. Your job is to manage it in a way that pleases the owner.

And the owner calls His managers (you) to give.



And when we give with the right attitude we are worshipping. Two key verses come to mind:

1) "Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Corinthians 9:7)

2) "Honor the Lord with your wealth..." (Proverbs 3:9)

When it comes to giving, where are you at? This topic is a big deal to Jesus, and it should be a big deal to us. Here is what I know: Sometimes the thing that keeps us from reaching out in deeper love for the Lord is our clinched hands on what we have. Giving encourages us to trust God. Giving puts us in a posture of dependence on Him. And while the Lord uses the resources you give to impact lives, you're the first person giving impacts.


Long time New Hope Church members, Rhonda and Rick Ehrhardt, were attracted to the church in the beginning for the same reasons they love the church now:
